1. Items included in cheat sheet:

- a. referee fees
- b. overtime procedure
- c. field markings (also see Rulebook p. 5-12)
- d. duration of play
- e. rule modifications at various levels

2. Inclement Weather:

The home coach will notify the referees of a postponement at least two hours before game time. If a game is to be rescheduled, the coaches must first agree upon a new date and time, and then contact their program director. I will only take reschedules from one designated person in each program.

Home team program directors can go to www.thearbiter.net to verify officials. The home team is responsible for contacting the official in case of weather postponements.

3. Four Goal Rule:

Team A shoots and scores. Team A is now leading by four goals. Instead of a draw, Team B's center will get the ball at the centerline. Center B will face her goal. Center A will be off to the side and ahead at a 45-degree angle and be four meters away. All other players will be in "draw" formation. At the whistle, center B may run with or pass the ball; she MAY NOT SHOOT until another player has played the ball. (p. 57)

4. 2007 Rule Changes:

Cones must be placed at the corners of the field
Clarification on mouthpiece; does NOT need to be colored.
Halftime will be 5 minutes.
No time out for retaking draw.
Center may not have any part of her hand in contact with the sidewall/pocket on draw.
If draw is illegal and fault cannot be determined, draw is retaken.
Yellow card rule.

5. Pilot Program for Youth Checking

Teams must consist entirely of 8th graders.

At least 2 coaches on each team must:

1. Attend a youth clinic sanctioned by US Lacrosse (3/21/07 at NDP 7:00)
2. Pass the coaching course taken online at US Lacrosse forward results to Michelle Steadman mkj2t@comcast.net
3. Fill out report after EACH game and send to US Lacrosse

A team must have at each home game a person designated to take stats regarding checking/carding fouls.

6. Travel Fees

Travel fees will be instituted for the following programs who receive officiating services from out of area. The fee will be a per date assessment paid at the end of the year.
