

MYLA 2007 Playoff seedings

1. Top 8 legible teams in each league by record are in playoffs
2. Teams are seeded 1 – 8 with 1 being the best record
3. 1 v 8, 2 v 7, 3 v 6, 4v5
4. Tie breakers - 2 teams
 - a. head to head
 - b. coin flip
5. Tie Breakers more than two teams
 - a. Best record against teams that are tied
 - b. If all teams did not play each other, the team with the best winning percentage within those teams will be the higher seed.
 - c. Draw cards
6. Coin flip and draw cards would only be used when best record and head to head determine a clear top 8. If there are ties which include more then the top 8, a coin flip or draw cards would be used for seeding to determine a play in for the 8th seed
7. The board has the right when teams are tied and only when tied to over ride the coin flip and or card draw to seed teams to accommodate travel for the first round only.
8. Total goals, games against other divisions, record against other play off teams will not be used as methods the determine seedings
9. Games where scores are not reported will be considered losses.
10. Games not played must have prior approval of the board to be not considered a loss. Teams unable to reschedule games must have prior approval of both Program Chairmen to be considered a forfeit
